## Transcript of Audio Clip with Rita Lewis

Rita: I think partly to get me out of the way they used to send me to Sunday school. So on Saturday I used to go to the Jewish Free School's Saturday Jewish services and Sunday I used to go to Sunday school. My mother was a bit worried about this and when she came down one weekend she went to see the teacher at the Sunday School who said, 'Oh, it's a shame Rita isn't a Christian. She would make a lovely little Christian' [laughs]. But, you know, you just got on with it, you know.

Interviewer: Do you remember if you experienced any anti-Semitism at the time?

Rita: I didn't. I think some might have done but I didn't personally experience any. I experienced much more in London than I ever did in Ely.
